Tommy Badon, UL Lafayette Coach Badon is the Head Coach at ULL and is one of the most sought after clinicians in the country. He has been a long time Level 1 and Level 2 Instructor in the USATF Coaches Ed Program. He is currently an instructor in the USTFCCA Track and Field Academy. During his over 15 years at ULL Coach Badon has developed 2 Olympians, Ndaba Mdhlongwa and Hollis Conway, the current US record holder in the high jump Indoors.



James Thomas, University of Oklahoma During his career he has coached 9 NCAA Champions, 138 NCAA All Americans and 9 Olympians. In 2022 he served as the USATF Indoor World Championships USTFCCA has named Coach Thomas a Regional Assistant Coach of the Year 11 times.



Don Babbitt, University of Georgia Coach Babbitt is in his 28th year at Georgia, and he is currently the Associate Head Coach of the program. 149 of his athletes have earned NCAA All American honors. He has coached 30 NCAA Champions, and 58 of Coach Babbitt's athletes have competed in either the Olympic Games and/or the World Championships.



Devlyn Lovell, Antonian Coll. Prep. HS Coach Lovell has led Antonian High School for the past 25 years, currently as the program's Head Coach. Coach Lovell has received 6 Coach of the Year awards between 2005 and 2020. He is a proud alum of East Texas State University where he was a member of the 1993 NCAA Regional Champ. Qualifying Team.
